## HISTORY AND ARCHAEOLOGY TEACHER WORKSHOP

On July 15 and 16 the Florida Public Archaeology Network will offer a teacher workshop at Flagler College addressing the history and archaeology of northeast Florida. It is designed to familiarize educators with archaeology resources for the classroom that can enhance learning opportunities in math, science, language arts, and social studies.

The workshop will use a book uniquely geared to northeast Florida. *Coquina Queries* was created by FPAN to explore archaeology and Florida's past through coquina, a unique stone native to the region. The publication offers a variety of hands-on activities and is aligned with Sunshine State Standards for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students, though they can be adapted for students of any age.
